Important Camp Information:

Transportation: Transportation to and from the Day Camp site is the responsibility of the parents. Car pools are encouraged and are part of the fun.

Uniforms: Camp uniform (for Scouts and staff) is the camp T-shirt. One shirt is included in the cost for every camper, and full-week volunteers will be issued two free shirts. Additional shirts may be purchased. These shirts will be given out upon arrival on Monday, and must be worn every day of camp. Comfortable shoes are a must. NO open-toed shoes, flip-flops or sandals. Be prepared: this is a rain or shine event.

Please send your child with lunch & a refillable water bottle. Lunch is scheduled around noon each day and will last approximately 30 minutes and then be followed by some type of "quiet time activity" which usually lasts approximately 30 minutes. Any parent is welcome to come in and have lunch with their child, but all campers are to remain in camp during lunch.

Health Forms: Anyone (youth and adults) participating in Day Camp MUST submit a complete and current BSA medical form (Parts A and B). PLEASE MAIL THE COMPLETED MEDICAL FORM WITH THIS REGISTRATION. Alternately, the completed medical form must be turned in Monday morning (June 27) upon arrival at camp. Scouts will not be allowed to remain in camp without this form. A Camp Health Officer will be on hand for first aid (not medical treatment) and to oversee the administration of any medications needed during day camp hours. Special Needs: If you have a Scout with special needs please inform the Day Camp Director and offer suggestions to assist the scout in completing as much of the program as he can. Our goal is to have fun!
